



Access and Practical Information for Lyme Regis helping everyone to have their best Dino Day ever!

How to get here

Location: The Shelters on Marine Parade, Lyme Regis seafront.

By Bus

First Bus, route 31, runs between Axminster and Dorchester. The X53 Jurassic Coast bus runs between Axminster and Weymouth. 9A runs between Exeter and Lyme Regis. X52 runs between Exeter and Bridport.

By Coach/bus

National Express coaches stop at Dorchester where you can transfer to the [Jurassic Coaster X51](#) bus to Lyme Regis.

By Train

The nearest railway station to Lyme Regis is at Axminster which is six miles away.

By Car, use town centre car parks:

[Broad Street car park](#) has 2 accessible spaces. Short stay car park with 36 spaces.
[Cobb Gate car park](#) has 1 accessible space. Short stay car park with 17 spaces.
[Charmouth Road car park](#) has 2 accessible spaces. Long stay car park with 386 spaces. 10 minute downhill walk to the town. There is one electric vehicle chargepoint.

[Holmbush car park](#) has 6 accessible spaces. Long stay car park with 393 total spaces. 10 minute downhill walk to the town. There are 3 electric vehicle chargepoints.

[Monmouth Beach and Cabanya car parks](#) have 13 accessible spaces. There are 282 spaces and these are the closest car parks to Monmouth Beach and The Cobb harbour. There are 2 electric vehicle chargepoints.

[Pitthouse car park](#) (NCP) has 2 accessible spaces. Long stay car park with 70 spaces. 5 minute downhill walk to the town.

[Woodmead car park](#) has 2 accessible spaces. 239 spaces with a 5 minute downhill walk to the town. There is one electric vehicle chargepoint.

Parking charges apply. Lower town car parks are likely to fill quickly.

For access to the performance area, the following car parks are close by and have a fairly flat route (10 mins walk): **Cobb Gate, Broad Street, Monmouth Beach and Cabanya** car parks. The other car parks are further away, involve a downhill walk and pavements which may be too narrow for wheelchair and mobility scooter users.

Disabled parking spaces

Blue Badge holders can park on the seafront (Cart Road), which is accessed through Cobb Gate car park at the bottom of the town. Blue Badge holders will receive one extra hour in addition to the ticket purchased when parking in car parks operated by Dorset Council. Exploring our venue

Where there are steps around the site, ramps and handrails are provided. Wheelchair users and those with mobility concerns may be dropped off by the Cobb Arms (What3Words: grudge.forgets.raven) or at the clock end of the walkway (What3Words: regime.poorly.laptops).
